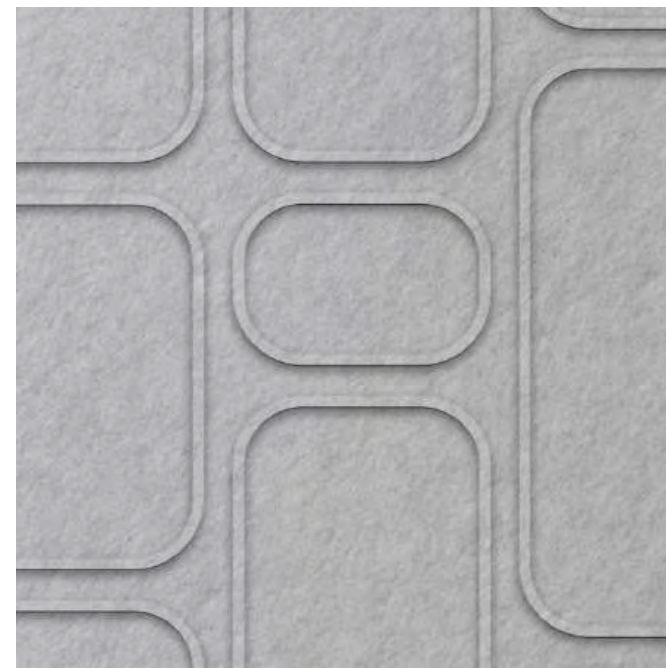


A-B-C panels can be repeated to create a unique and full patterned wall.

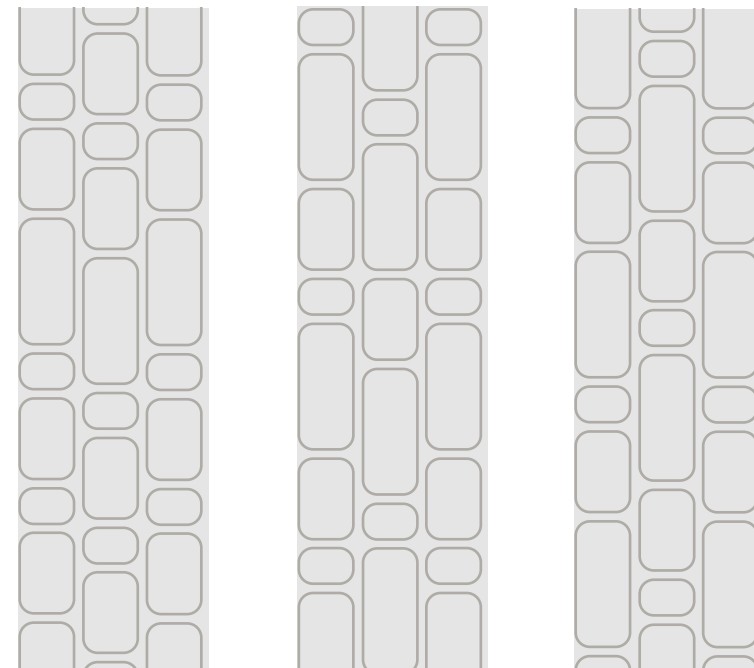

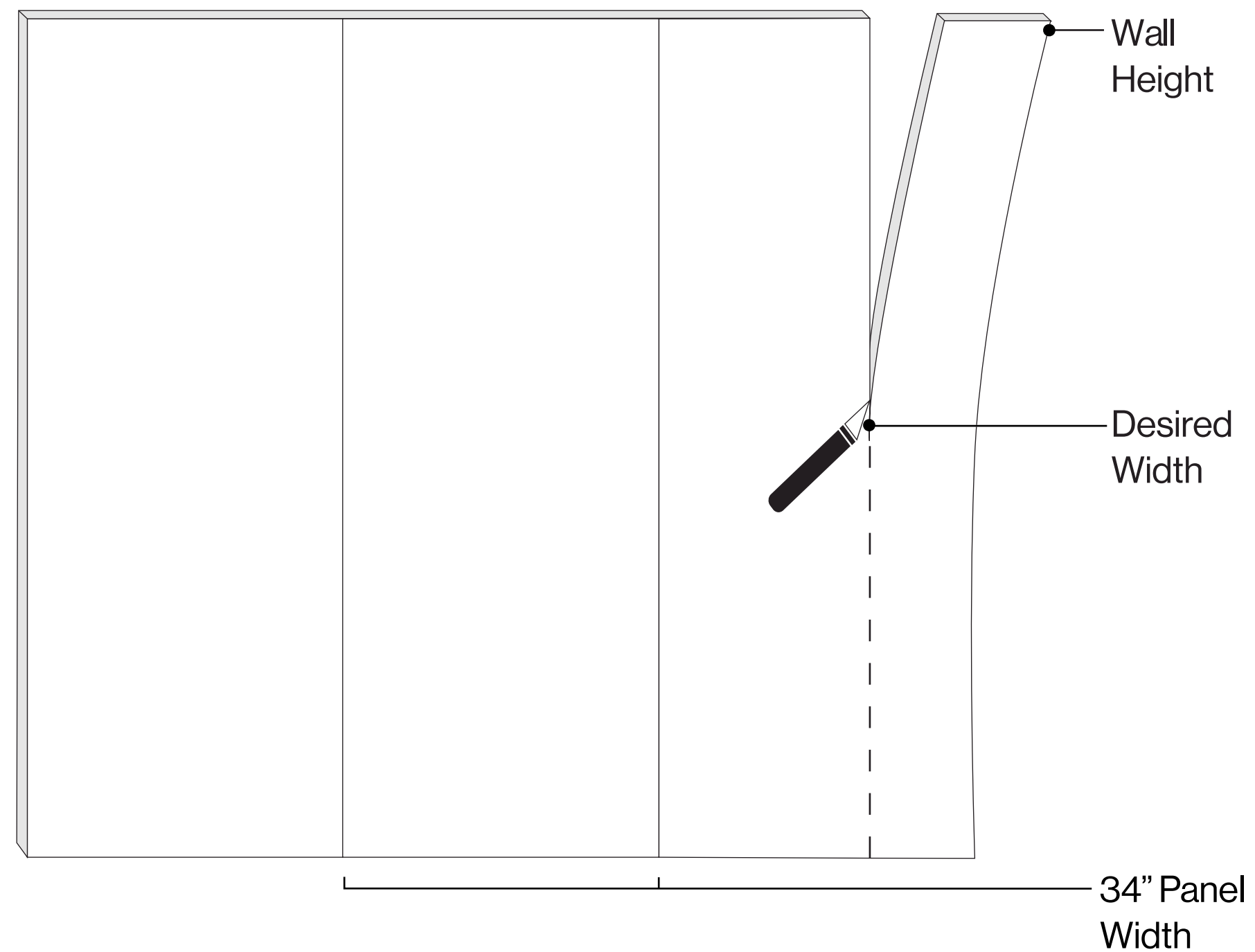
Installation

How it Works



General Recommendations

Standard Practice

Installed much like wallpaper, these panels are directly glued to the substrate. Each panel aligns edge-to-edge, ensuring a continuous expansion of the design across the wall.

Factory Edges

Panels are available in a standard width of 34 inches, finished with a straight edge and fabricated to the desired height.

Trim on Site

The panels can be easily trimmed to fit your specific space. For precise trimming, we recommend using a sharp blade and a metal straight edge. It's important to change blades regularly to ensure a clean cut without pulling or dragging the material.

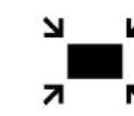

Good to Know

Variation

With wool felt being a natural material there may be natural variation within the material. This may include rare colored dots known as Smit Marks, color variation due to the natural wool color variation and the absorption of dyes, or fine vegetable matter. Complete color consistency is not guaranteed nor can it be expected, however if particular areas of a project site require higher consistency please inform us well in advance and we can do our best to accommodate by supplying similar dye lots when possible.

Maintenance

Handle with care. To remove any accumulation of airborne particles, Interior Felt products can be occasionally vacuumed with an upholstery brush, brushed by hand or with a lint brush or roller. When dusting, it is normal to encounter a slight shedding of fibers. These loosened fibers are not a sign of any defect and will decrease over time.

Wet spills should be blotted up as soon as possible with a dry cloth. All wool fibers have a naturally-occurring fatty coating called lanolin. This substance makes wool water-repellent and provides inherent stain resistance. Felt is not waterproof, but its inherent resistance to liquids creates some delay time before spills soak through and cause a stain.

Other wet spills may be spot cleaned with warm water or a mild dry-cleaning solvent. Clean soiled areas gingerly to avoid warping the felted surface.

Helpful Tips:

We strongly recommend testing any cleaning method on spare material or less visible areas first.

In addition to occasional dusting, felt products may need to be vacuumed once per year.

If stains cannot be removed with spot cleaning, we recommend seeking professional dry cleaning services that have experience with wool.
